- •This entry combines second-floor neighborhood service office space with high quality ground floor retail in a building visible to a major regional roadway.
- •First floor space has direct exterior access, prominent signage, and no core, while second floor has a central lobby just for those tenants.
- •The exterior facade brick field with light brick accents for lintels and banding and a detailed cornice and aluminum composite panels provide a contemporary façade.
- •The windows are punched openings, limited to 10' to allow for loose steel lintel supports which results in large savings on the steel structure.


