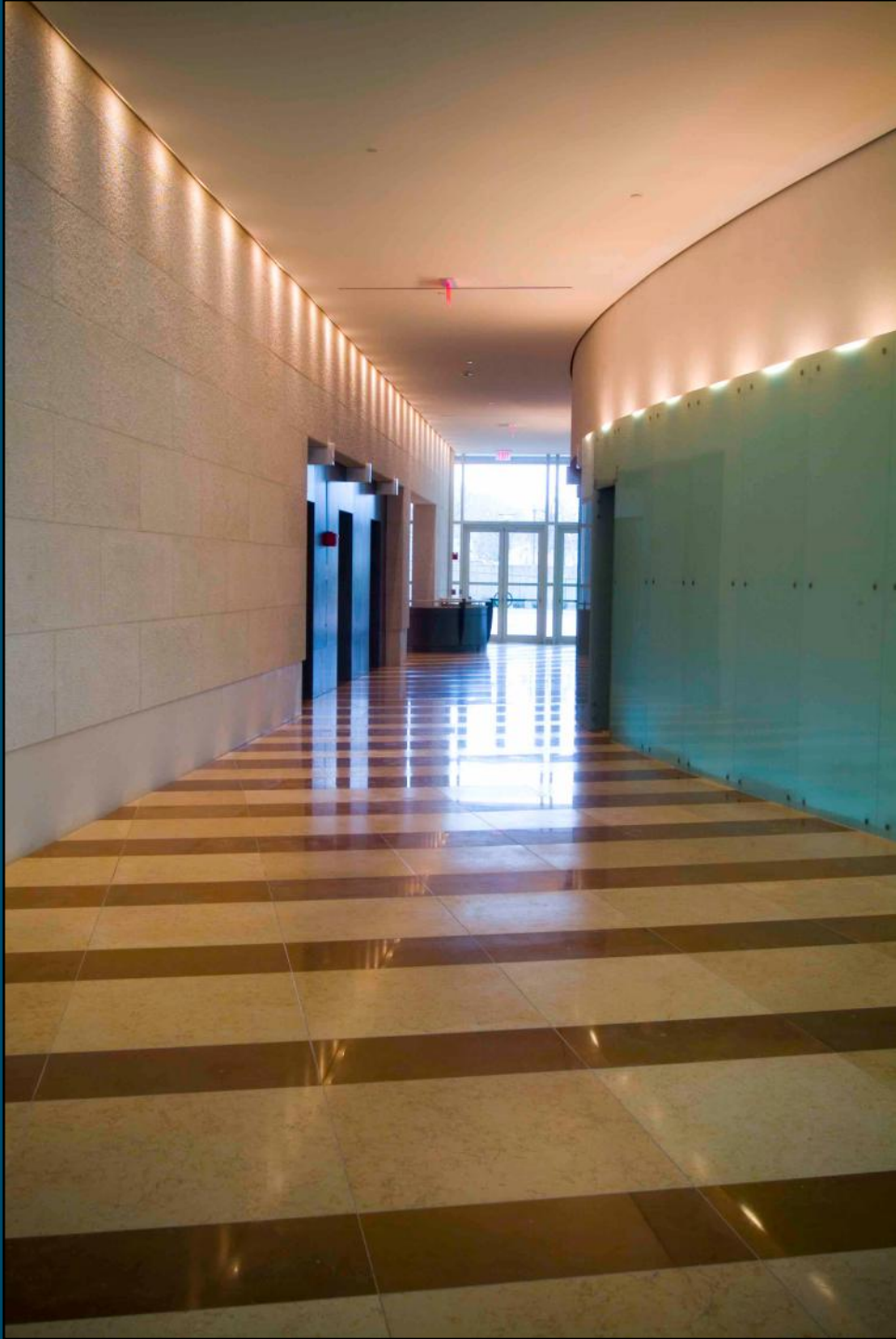
Judges' Comments:
