



The Need for Redevelopment



- 32 Year old, suburban regional shopping mall with an inward-focus
- Steady decline in sales and occupancy
- Major renovation required to attract new retailers – street connectivity, visibility, accessibility from garage
- Create an amenity that improves property values, attracts new residents / employers and contributes to the overall vitality of the community



Redevelopment Overview



- 850,000 square foot redevelopment including
 - 350,000 square feet of shopping, dining, service and entertainment
 - 22 story, 406 unit residential tower
 - Renovation of the Ballston Office Tower
- Public Improvements
 - Community amenities plaza and enhanced streetscape including 20' wide sidewalks
 - New pedestrian bridge spanning Wilson Blvd
 - Renovation of the 3,000 space Ballston Garage













